#### INFORMATION CLAUSE

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the general regulation on the protection of personal data of 27 April 2016 (Journal of Laws UE L 119 of 04/05/2016) on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / WE - general regulation on data protection (Journal of Laws UE L 119/1 of 04/05/2016), Bydgoszcz University of Science and Technology informs that:

3. Your personal data will be processed:
  - 1) for the purposes of the currently announced recruitment - pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. b of the general regulation on data protection of April 27, 2016 and the Labor Code of June 26, 1974 in order to conclude a contract,
  - 2) for future recruitments if you give your consent pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a of the regulation, expressed in writing for the period specified in the consent declaration,
4. Your personal data, in the event of failure to conclude the contract, will be kept for a period of up to 6 months or the time specified in the consent statement,
5. The recipients of your personal data will only be entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of legal provisions and entities cooperating in the recruitment process, your data will not be transferred to a third country, except for cases resulting from your express request,
6. You have the right to request the administrator to access your personal data, the right to request rectification, deletion or limitation of processing, the right to object to the processing, the right to transfer data, and if consent is granted, the right to withdraw it in any time,
7. Providing personal data for ongoing recruitment is a statutory requirement of the Labor Law. The consequence of not providing data is exclusion from recruitment.
8. Providing personal data for the purposes of future recruitment is voluntary and does not affect the course and results of ongoing recruitment.
9. You have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office,
10. Your data will be processed partially automatically, with the possibility of profiling. Automatic decision-making is not used to recruit employees.
